Adoption UK	E-Project will support specifically adopted young people (AYP) or living in/having lived in kinship care families to plan for their future with links to FE/HE.
Street League	Connected will engage the over 20s YP, providing an outreach and engagement within their local communities via one to one appointments or classroom based activities.
Cyrenians	Getting Together will offer real-life practical experiences to YP from Gypsy Traveller community to build on existing skills and prepare for work.
ENABLE Scotland	Breaking Barriers will offer YP who have learning disabilities support via partnership with Napier University to attain an accredited qualification and achieve employment opportunities.
Move On	Employability Pathway will deliver an employability programme offering a combination of group work and one-to-one support, using a person-centred, flexible and asset-based approach at Stage 2.

Access to Industry	Access Mechanics in partnership with GTG will deliver a 10-week introduction to mechanics course that will enable YP to gain accredited learning and skills.
Barnardo's	Drive2Work provision is targeted at YP aged 20-24 (exceptions for young people over the age of 17 will apply) with multiple barriers to employment residing on the outskirts of the City Centre. Looking at skills for driving and job opportunities.
Young Enterprise Scotland	Bridge to Business will support YP at Edinburgh College to understand enterprise for employment, including start up grants for x10 YP.
RUTS	INSPIRE will support young people aged 16-24, with barriers to employment to achieve a positive destination including sector specific qualifications and opportunities.
Articulate Cultural Trust	Creative Potentials will deliver a training, work experience, skills and personal development programme preparing care experienced and other disadvantaged young people for a career in the creative industries, including creative qualifications and ongoing support.
