



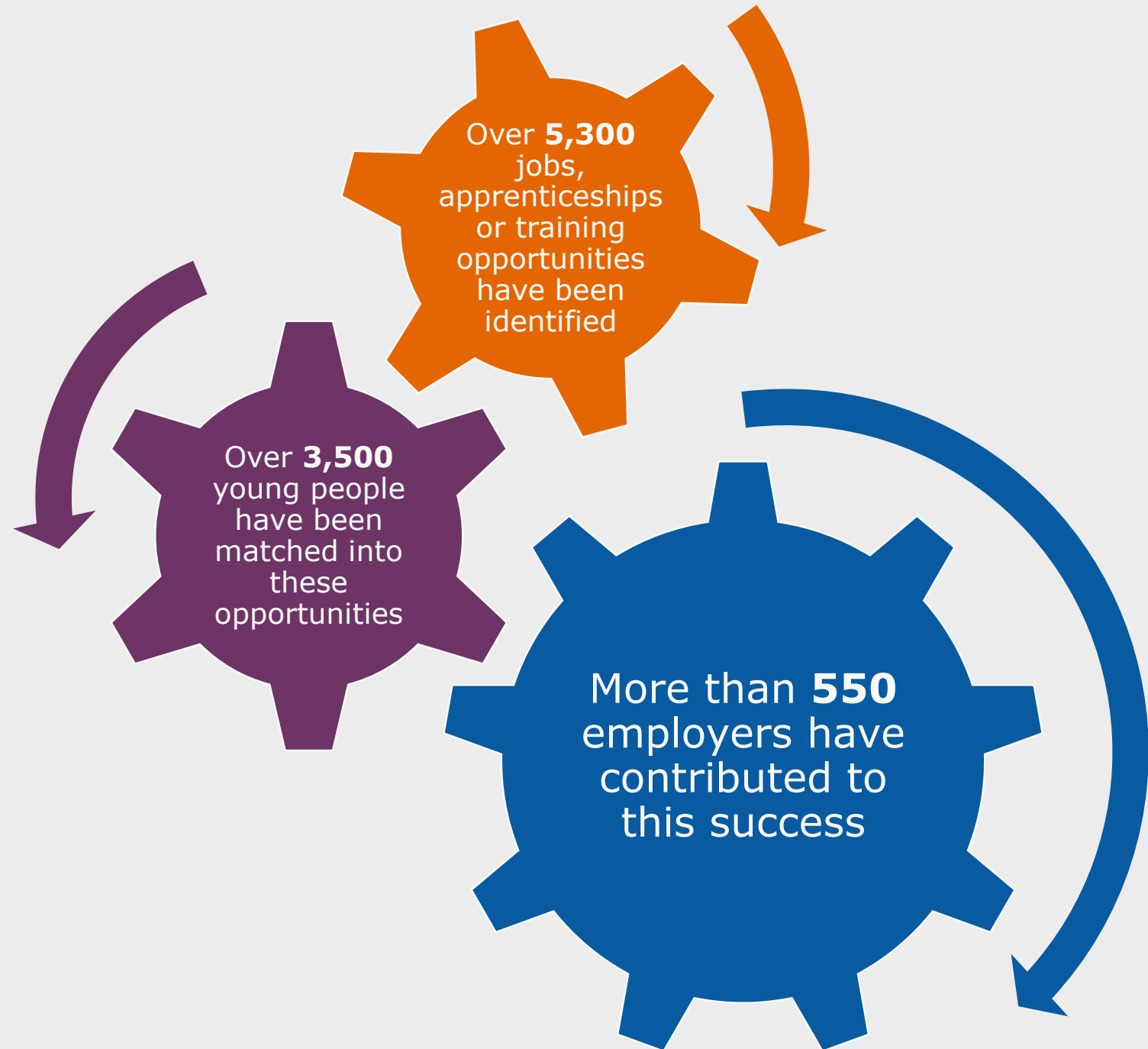

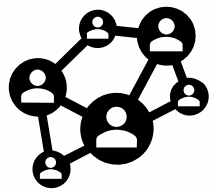
The Edinburgh Guarantee

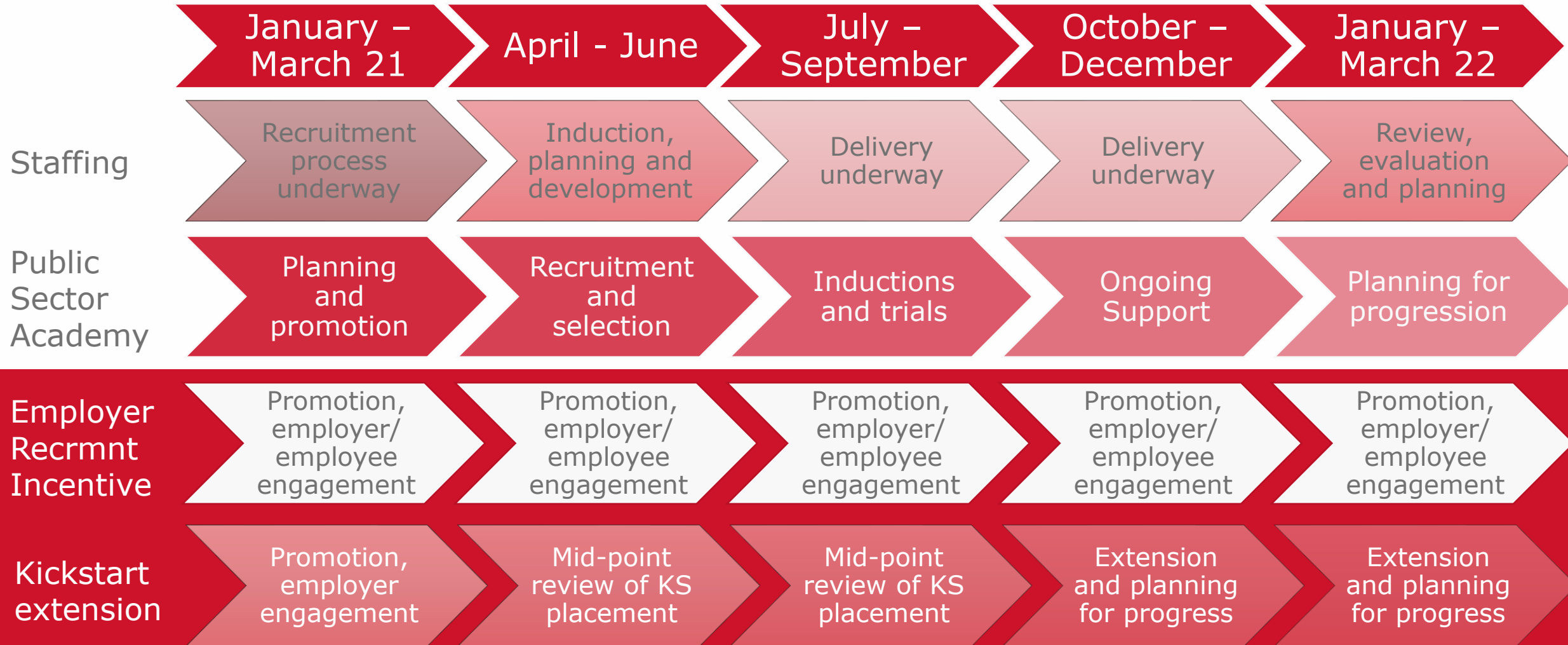

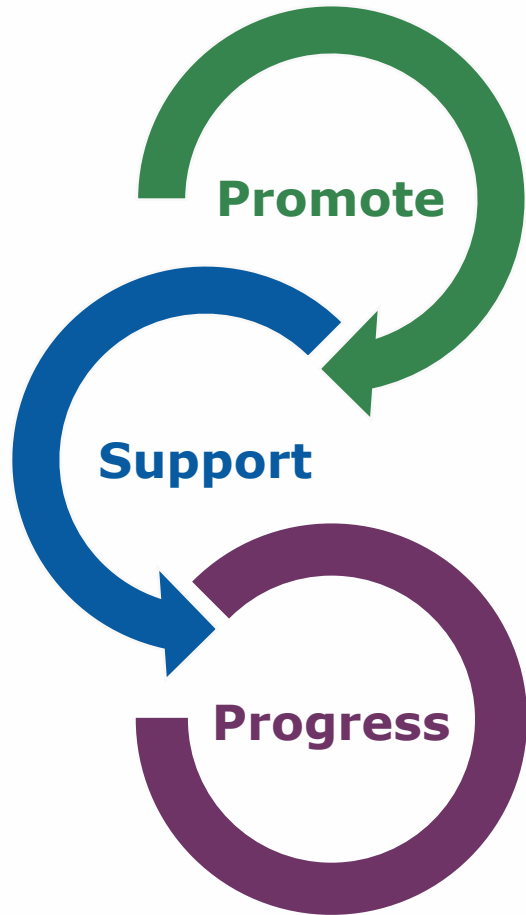
