Support for people at the earliest stage of the pipeline

About Moving Forward

- A designated person-centred service for young people aged 16 – 19 (up to 26 if care experienced or have a disability) at the earliest stages of the employability pipeline.
- An intervention for the city's most vulnerable young people who will be leaving school or left school with no positive destination
- The service is offered across all city of Edinburgh Secondary schools and special education schools
- Specialist ASN provision provided citywide
- Family support to parents of young people eligible for the service

Partnership

There are 6 partners delivering across 7 cluster areas of the city. This ensures a designated Moving Forward link with schools to encourage referrals and stronger partnership working. The following partners cover each area:

ASN Service

- Citywide provision for young people leaving or left school with no positive destination and identifies as having ASN Delivered by Barnardos
- One to one tailored support to the individuals needs
- Focussing on strength based support and interventions to meet the needs of the young people
- Multi agency approach to ensure correct agencies involved in meeting the needs and requirements of individual
- Longer term provision to build relationships and follow young person into sustained positive provision.

Moving On Parents

- Each cluster has a designated parent support provision
- To engage with parents of eligible young people on a one to one person-centred model. Building a positive relationship and identifying goals and needs of parents as they transition.
- Provide support and signposting to meet their needs for their next stage in life.
- Support is offered for up to a year

Referral Pathways
